## What can we help with?



**P4SP** is a project by the Australian Government.



P4SP helps Pacific countries to improve their **social protection**.

**Social protection** means things that the government gives a person to



- have money to buy things like food



- do things like see a doctor



- recover when something that is not planned happens, like losing a job or being in a flood.



We help in many ways.

We

- send **advisors** to Pacific countries to help make their social protection systems stronger.



**Advisors** are people who know a lot about something and help other people to learn.



- help governments learn how to



- make social protection systems that help the people who need it the most



- develop good instructions to help implement social protection systems

- make their social protection systems work better by making small improvements over time.



- do research to help Pacific countries know more about social protection.



- talk to governments and organisations about working together to improve social protection systems.



- help Pacific countries to do new things that improve social protection.

## What we are doing



We work together with Pacific countries to do many things.

In Fiji we are helping the government to



- improve Fiji's social protection systems



- apply recommendations to improve how social protection works



- update the social protection instructions



- make a database that makes it easier to manage social protection systems.

In Kiribati we are helping the government to



- use their new rules about social protection



- support the team that will manage Kiribati's social protection programs



- do the things they must do to give social protection to people in Kiribati.

In Tonga we are helping the government to



- make social protection stronger for



- older people



- people with disabilities

- write a **manual** that says how to do social protection work for older people.



A **manual** is a book that tells you how to do different parts of a job.

We are helping Vanuatu to start work on social protection.



We can also help you learn about social protection.
